



## No War with Iran

We are the 50th Chicano Moratorium Organizing Committee - a joint effort of various unions, individuals, organizations – some labor affiliated, and supporters embarking on a mission to commemorate the anniversary of the 50th Anniversary Chicano Moratorium - which took place on August 29, 1970. In 1970 we were faced with a high casualty rate and massive drafting of Chicanos to fight in the U.S. war against the people of Vietnam. We demanded a stop to our drafting, our high casualties, and the inability to best help us once we returned home.

Currently U.S. President Trump has taken it upon himself to wage new attacks on the people and government of Iran. We are firmly opposed to war, and firmly against interference at the hands of the U.S. We oppose a war on Iran and demand the US out of Iraq.

Military recruiters target high schools, especially in Chicano and Black neighborhoods. The 50<sup>th</sup> Chicano Moratorium Committee calls on all to join our efforts for a protest on **January 25, 11:00 AM, at the U.S. Marines Recruitment Center located at 1241 S Soto St, Los Angeles, CA 90023.**

Though the draft does not currently exist, the lack of decent-paying jobs and income disparity causes countless Chicanos to enlist in the military. Many are immigrants looking to become legalized, homeless, hungry, uninsured, or seeking a better education but unable to afford it. Not one more war!
